Guidance for church service

- 1. Please ensure you arrive early for the church service as there is a limit on capacity. Entry will be refused once the church is at capacity.
- 2. If you have had any symptoms of Covid19 recently, please do not attend. A temperature check can be performed. Your temperature should not exceed 37.8°C.
- 3. **NHS track and trace will** be used at the church. Your name and contact telephone number will be required upon entry. The information will be disposed of after 21days. (refusal to provide this information will result in non admittance)
- 4. You must enter the at the normal entrance and exit via the approved door/gate.
- 5. The wearing of masks and gloves are advised for entry.
- 6. Please use the hand sanitiser upon entry.
- 7. Once the service is at capacity we will refuse entry until someone has vacated the premises.
- 8. Please stay in your seat for the duration of the service, this includes feasts and memorials.
- 9. Please wait in your seat until your bench is called by a committee member for holy communion distribution. (in some instances holy communion may not be held).
- 10. Kollyva must be placed in bags ready before it is brought to the church, it will then be given out as you exit the church.
- 11. At the end of the service you must remain seated until a committee member calls your bench to create an orderly exit for your safety.

 Antideron will be given by the priest.

Sorry if these guidelines seem extreme but under the current circumstances we are having to take extreme measures for everyones safety.
